## Minutes

June 2nd, 2025

- I. **Attendance:** Stacy Breden, Paul Hartshorn, Michael Nikula, Roger Peterson, Douglas B Perfetto
  - A. Supervisor Hartshorn called the meeting to order at 9:08am. Waving of the National Anthem due to the nature of the meeting.
  - B. MOTION: To approve the Road Special Meeting Agenda. Motioned by Supervisor Nikula , Seconded by Peterson , Passed by unanimous consent.
- II. **Road Tour followed the Plow Route**
  - A. **Tiffanie Lane:** Needs a bit of dirt dropped at the beginning of the road.
  - B. **Klinker Road:** Grading and 1 Culvert needed
  - C. **Ostman Road:** Grading
  - D. **Cooper Road:** Fill in turn around area, ditching on the hill
  - E. **Mattson Road:** Class 5 on sections, turn around needs fill. Currently in the process of getting a new culvert. NO ROAD SIGN
  - F. **Stenberg Road:** In good shape
  - G. **Laurel Lane :** Little dirt needed
  - H. **Timberline Trail:** Turn around needs some dirt
  - I. **Park Hill Road:** Needs dirt on the first part of the road and ditching. Supervisor Peterson will look into what it takes to have CLP come and remove some trees from under the powerline on the left side as you go up the road before Bredens. Look into making the second part on Park Hill Minimum Maintenance.
  - J. **Nikolai Road:** Bigger bypass pipes needed, more gravel. Supervisor Peterson suggested taking the washout gravel from the woodline for the road and maybe narrowing the road a bit.
  - K. **Leskinen Road:** Hill needs gravel, in the future possible 2 cross pipes will need replacement.
  - L. **Roses Road:** Grading at the end of the road
  - M. **Pebbles Lane:** In good shape
  - N. **Air Base Road:** Is ok
  - O. **Silver Hill Road:** Is in good shape/ MISSING ROAD SIGN (by the church side)
  - P. **Salveson Road:** Supervisor Peterson suggested moving two of the cement barricades that are in Salvesons yard into the road more to block off the bank. Doug noted that the County told him that they have secured funds to do a study on the Baptism River for the bank washout.

- Q. Riverside Drive:** Entrance by Nikulas side of Riverside has several dead trees in the powerline. Supervisor Peterson was going to make a phone call and see what could be done there.
- R. Breezy Lane:** In good shape
- S. Menace Lane :** In good shape (bit of grading)
- T. Clair Nelson Community Center Parking Lot:** Dirt to be dropped and spread, county to remove the rocks for the Mattson Road project.
- U. Gregg Field Parking Lot:** In good shape
