Special Meeting: Road Tour

6553 Hwy 1, Finland MN and 11 miles of Township Roads

42.5 miles of travel.

## Minutes

April 29th, 2026

- I. **Attendance:** Stacy Breden, Paul Hartshorn, Michael Nikula, Roger Peterson, Douglas B Perfetto, Jon Goette, Eric Lindberg
  - A. Supervisor Hartshorn called the meeting to order at 9:02am. Waving of the National Anthem due to the nature of the meeting.
  - B. MOTION: To approve the Road Special Meeting Agenda. Motioned by Supervisor Peterson, Seconded by Supervisor Hartshorn, Passed by unanimous consent.
  - C. Given that this meeting will be a road tour and it will be impractical to record, I move that we waive our policy of recording meetings for today's meeting.
- II. **Road Tour followed the Plow Route**
  - A. **Tiffanie Lane:** Needs a bit of dirt dropped at the beginning of the road and shimming
  - B. **Klinker Road:** Grading, ditching, gravel on turn around
  - C. **Ostman Road:** Grading, and gravel needed.
  - D. **Cooper Road:** Fill in turn around area, 3 inch minus and gravel by Culvert and up the hill, ditching needed.
  - E. **Mattson Road:** The big Culvert held up nicely, a bit of Ice Damming from the winter but no big issues. Fiber Optic is still an issue for ditching, Doug has a road sign ordered. Class 5 needed past the big culvert. Turn around is difficult in the winter and needs gravel 3inch minus.
  - F. **Stenberg Road:** Gravel on road
  - G. **Laurel Lane :** Class 5 and grading
  - H. **Timberline Trail:** Eric Lindberg joined the Tour for his road, he is concerned about the Ledge Rock just past his driveway on the upper side of the road causing flooding. He asked if he could ditch to help the backed up water flow out. The Town Board said go ahead just don't ditch too close to the road right of way.
  - I. **Nikolai Road:** Bit of Gravel needed.
  - J. **Gravel Pit:** 3 inch minus and Class 1 piles. Class 1 is about 1,500 YD and 3 inch minus around 2,500CY in piles.
  - K. **Cemetery:** Move the Archway to the middle, the Silver Bay Vets Home is going to donate a statue of a kneeling soldier to place in front of the Kiosk.
  - L. **Leskinen Road:** Hill needs gravel, in the future possible 2 cross pipes will need replacement. Bigger Culvert should be a D shaped one. Road needs Grading.

- M. Roses Road:** Grading at the end of the road, culvert needs repairing just past the trailer court. Turn around, and put a new culvert in across the road just below Bemlott's and above Bizuwork's property.
- N. Park Hill Road:** Trees were removed last year on the first part of Park Hill Road. Need to Drop 6inches of 3inch minus beyond the hill all the way to Jason's Driveway. Need to fix Williams Culvert, cut it off or replace it. The second half of Park Hill needs some digging out and the 2nd turnaround needs class 1.
- O. Pebbles Lane:** In good shape, trees need to be out of the right of way.
- P. Air Base Road:** Brushing from behind the guard rails is needed. Supervisor Peterson asks Stacy to reach out to the County Engineer and see if they would be interested in meeting with Pudgy and a Supervisor to discuss blacktopping. Doug notes that there is a cement gutter that needs to be cleaned out.
- Q. S. Silver Hill Road:** Gravel and Grade/ fixing of culvert. Supervisors asked Stacy to look into information for the Board to possibly consider abandoning Tikkanen's driveway.
  - 1. Supervisor Hartshorn mentioned possibly abandoning Ostman Road too.
- R. N. Silver Hill Road:** Ditching on the North Side by Peterson and VanBergen's needs.
- S. Salveson Road:** Stacy Contact Lake County Water and Soil and see where they are on the Salveson Road project.
- T. North Riverside Drive:** Trees were removed by Nikulas last Fall. Culvert needed before Job Goettes Driveway. Mailboxes are too close to the road on the straight stretch. South Side is in good condition.
- U. Breezy Lane:** Trees on phone lines need to be removed.
- V. Menace Lane :** Ruts in the road due to washout, #5074/#5076 water running down private drive is causing issues on Menace.
- W. Clair Nelson Center** needs some gravel spread out at the turn around.
- X. Gregg Field** Doug is going to put a No Camping sign up.

**III. Priorities**

- A. The Town Board advises Doug to take care of washouts on Menace right away and other washouts after that. Also grade all roads once, then bring other issues to the board after that. Doug notes being worried about going over his 24hrs a week. The Board says that these issues need to be handled ASAP and are the priorities so get them done even if it's over 24hrs in one week.

**VI. CLOSE MEETING:** MOTION: to adjourn the meeting at 12:00 pm Motioned by Supervisor Nikula , Secoded by Supervisor Peterson , Passed by unanimous consent.
