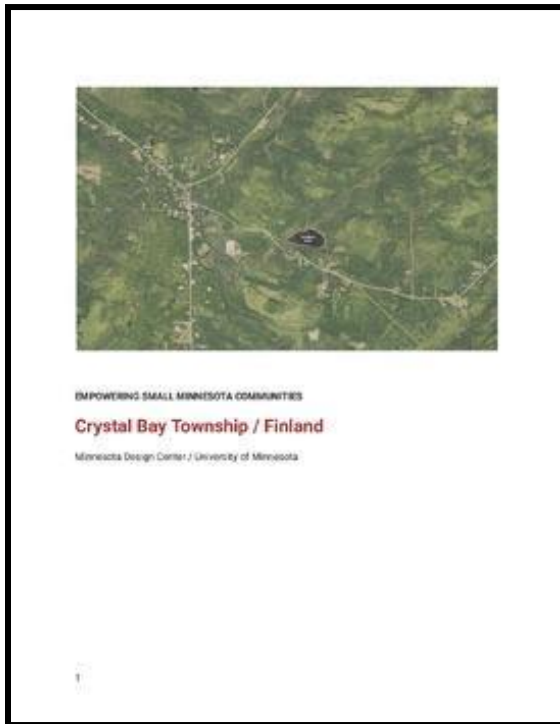


Empowering Small Minnesota Communities: Crystal Bay Township / Finland



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Abstract

In Community Futures efforts, the University team collaborates with community partners to develop a community scale strategy, and to help identify actionable and fundable projects related to infrastructure to support that strategy, and that the community can carry forward. This strategic partnership effort is approximately 9-18 months. For the Finland community and Crystal Bay Township, this ESMC partnership focused on supporting and carrying forward grassroots research and community learning already underway; community engagement and facilitation for sharing findings and inviting participation; strategic partnership, research support and facilitation to identify priority areas for effort and set up the community to carry forward housing-related projects; support to connect, build and strengthen relationships with county, regional and state partners.
